## Mosquito Activity:

Total mosquito numbers exploded this week after a dip during epi week 25. This was driven by a large emergence of *Cq. perturbans*, reaching 34 times the total collected last week. *Cq. perturbans* was abundant at almost all sites throughout the district. We also saw increases in the total *Cx. pipiens/restuans* and *Cs. melanura* collected, both species totals increasing nearly fourfold. There was a large increase in abundance of *Cx. salinarius* and *Oc. thibaulti* in some traps. Gravid traps were much more productive this week than previous weeks, allowing for the increase in submitted *Cx. pipiens/restuans* pools.
