## Mosquito Activity:

Total mosquito catch decreased this week. There was a 38% drop in total *Cq. perturbans* in traps, though the numbers still remain higher than 2019 abundance during epiweek 27. Gravid traps remain very productive this week, *Cx. pipiens/restuans* totals increased by 14% from last week and are higher than epi week 27's 2019 abundance. *Cx. salinarius* numbers continue to climb as well, however epiweek 27 in 2019 saw huge numbers of *Cx. salinarius* that were well above this week's totals. *Oc. thibaulti* numbers increased again this week and remains consistent with 2019 abundance. *Oc. canadensis* has started its slow decline, and many other early spring mosquito numbers are waning.
